Acceptance notification will be sent to the first author by May 1 (Saturday), 2010 with detailed information, and your full paper is due on May 31 (Monday), 2010 in camera ready format.

* The outstanding research paper will be invited for submission to the *International Journal for Educational Media and Technology*, a peer refereed international journal, ISSN 1882-2290.

2) Round Tables Papers**

The Round Tables proposal is one page abstract of your research with no more than 300 words. If your Round Table proposal is accepted, the paper for Round Table should be sent by May 31 (Monday), 2010 in camera ready format.
