## プログラム Programs

### 一般プログラム General Program

一定の日本語能力を有する留学生は、原則として、正規学生向けの学部・大学院の科目を含む、次頁にあるすべてのコースから希望する科目を選択することが可能です。語学力に応じて、日本語科目のみを履修することも可能です。一般プログラム生は半期 6 科目以上履修が目安です。春・秋学期のいずれからでも入学可能で、留学期間は半期又は 1 年です。  
**(語学要件) JLPT N4 以上、CEFR A2 以上** の日本語能力が望ましいです。

As a general rule, General Program students who have acquired a certain level of Japanese language proficiency can take any courses indicated on the next page, including full-time undergraduate and graduate courses. Depending on your Japanese language proficiency, you can focus only on taking Japanese language courses. General Program students are recommended to take at least 6 courses in one semester. Students can be enrolled either from Spring or Autumn Semester. Duration should be one semester or two semesters.  
**Japanese language requirement: JLPT N4 / CEFR A2 or higher is preferable.**

### ISEP International Student Education Program

ISEP はキャンパス内外の活動を通じて日本を探求する特別プログラムです。参加者は、学校訪問、地域探求、芸術やスポーツの実践活動など、さまざまな体験を通じて充実した学習を行います。また、参加学生は指導教員のもとで、個人研究プロジェクトに取り組み、英語で論文を執筆します。テーマは、日本社会、文化、芸術、教育、科学など、各自の専門や関心にもとづく幅広い分野から選ぶことができます。さらに ISEP では、多様な日本語コースや、教育学、人文学、社会科学、自然科学、芸術、スポーツなどの学問分野を英語で学ぶコースも提供しています。ISEP 申請者は、選考委員会による審査が実施されます。また、プログラム参加年度に協定校の学部にて在学し、原則として 1 年次を修了している学生とします。

**修了要件：**半期あたり合計 12 単位（英語で行われる ISEP Seminar 2 単位と個人研究 1 単位のほかは、英語で行われる Global Japan Studies や日本語科目など、学生の専門、関心、語学力に応じた履修が可能）。

**推奨される語学力：**TOEFL iBT 72, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC L&R/S&W 1560, Cambridge English Qualifications 160（英語を母国語とする場合は不要）

#### **JASSO 海外留学支援制度による奨学金の支給について：**

2027 年 4 月から ISEP プログラムに参加する留学生は、JASSO 海外留学支援制度による奨学金を受給できる可能性があります（月額 8 万円）。  
人数枠には上限があります。ISEP に申請のあった留学生から本学で受給者を選抜するため、奨学金について個別の申請は不要です。

ISEP is a special program that explores Japan through both on-campus and off-campus activities. Participants are offered various experiences, including school visits, excursions to downtown areas, and hands-on activities in arts and sports, all designed to enrich immersive learning. Additionally, participants engage in an Individual Study project and produce a paper in English with a guidance by a supervisory professor. Topics range from social and cultural issues to arts, education, sciences, and other subjects of individual interest. ISEP also offers a diverse selection of Japanese language courses as well as English-taught courses examining various academic fields such as pedagogy, humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, arts, and sports. Applicants for the ISEP will be reviewed by the Selection Committee. In addition, they must be enrolled in a faculty at a partner university during the year of participation and, in principle, must have completed their first year of study.

**Completion Requirements:** A total of 12 credits per semester, in addition to 2 credits for ISEP Seminar and 1 credit for Individual Study, students can take courses in the Japanese language or Global Japan Studies conducted in English, depending on their major, interests, and language proficiency.

**Recommended English language Proficiency:** TOEFL iBT 72, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC L&R/S&W 1560, Cambridge English Qualifications 160 (for non-English-native applicants only)

**Scholarship Provided by JASSO:** Students joining the ISEP program from April 2027 may be eligible for the JASSO scholarship (80,000 JPY per month). There is an upper limit to the number of scholarships available. TGU will select scholarship recipients from the ISEP applicants. Students do not need to submit applications for the scholarship.

## 授業内容 Content

授業科目は大きく分けて以下の 5 つのカテゴリーがあります。

各学期の始め 2 週間が履修登録期間になっていて、履修を希望する授業を実際に受講しながら、決定します。授業は週に 1 回 100 分、1 学期あたり 14 週行われます。日本語科目や実習科目、フィールドトリップ科目は 1 単位、講義・演習は 2 単位となります。

各留学生には、学生の研究テーマや興味に応じて指導教員が指定されますので、指導教員に相談しながら授業を選択することもできます。

There are 5 categories of courses. The first 2 weeks of each semester are the registration period.

Students can try to attend the courses they are interested in during this period and decide which courses to take. The duration of each class is 100 minutes, and there will be 14 weeks each semester. In principle, Japanese Language Courses, hands-on learning, and field study courses have one credit, and other classroom lectures have two credits.

An academic advisor will be appointed to each exchange student, who is a professor specializing in your research theme or interest. Students can also consult their academic advisor about the courses they should take.
